## This funding will be used to increase the percentage of:

- Years 3 and 5 students achieving “U2B” in Reading and Numeracy to 35%;
- Students achieving a ‘C’ standard or above in English by 5% in all year levels;
- Students achieving a ‘B’ standard or above in English by 5% in all year levels; and
- Years 3 and 5 students meeting the National Minimum Standard in Reading to 100% (or develop an Individual Curriculum Plan for students who are below).

## Our initiatives include

- Increase teachers’ repertoire of effective strategies for teaching English/Reading;
- Provide professional development and coaching to ensure teachers are able to plan and deliver highly effective, differentiated learning experiences;
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support and those with potential to achieve high results;
- Continue a Professional Learning Community of teachers to share and evaluate strategies and their impact (PODs/Collaborative Cycles of Inquiry); and
- Maintain/sustain Learning Journey Groups to enhance NAPLAN Plan.
