



Uniform and Stationery

Nerang Primary School is a uniformed school and the dress policy is designed to meet the needs of the community. Nerang also has the policy 'wear a hat to play' as a sun smart concern for the welfare of the students.

Daily School Uniform

Students have an option to wear navy blue shorts or skorts. Hats must be the school wide brim with school logo purchased from the school Uniform Shop. Students who still have the checked uniforms (shirts and dresses) may continue to wear these.

Sports Days

Students are encouraged to wear a sun safe polo shirt in their house colour for sports days including swimming carnival, cross country etc.

HATS	Prep – gold wide brimmed with school logo Years 1 to 6 – navy wide brimmed with school logo
SHOES	Black covered in with laces or velcro
SOCKS	White or black only
WINTER <i>(Limited supply)</i>	Plain navy jumper or jacket is also acceptable. Hooded jackets are not acceptable. Navy tracksuit pants or tailored dance pants are allowed to be worn with senior shirts, school shirts or checked shirts. Girls have the option of wearing navy or flesh colour tights or leggings stockings under their shorts or skorts.
HAIR	Keep neat and tidy at all times. Hair below shoulder length must be tied back at all times and accessories must be navy/gold/yellow. Unnatural hair colouring or styling is not permitted.
JEWELLERY	A watch can be worn and one pair of sensible earrings e.g. plain sleepers or studs. Facial piercing is not permitted. Smart watches are subject to our Phone policy and should be held at the office if able to be connected to a network.
MAKE-UP	Make up and nail polish are not permitted

Out of Uniform

If for some unavoidable reason your child is unable to wear the correct uniform on a particular day, please send a note to school explaining the reason for this as well as a date that the child will be in the correct attire. For students with no explanation note an inappropriate uniform note will be issued and must be taken home and signed by the parent/guardian. If a reasonable excuse is not offered or with repeat offenders, the school behaviour policy will apply.
