

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2020  
Nerang State School will receive:

**\$278,620**

## This funding will be used to increase the percentage of:

- Students in Years 3 and 5 achieving U2B (Upper Two Bands) in Reading and Numeracy to 35%;
- Students in Years 3 and 5 meeting NMS (National Minimum Standards) in Reading to 100% (or develop an Individual Curriculum Plan for students who are below);
- Students achieving a 'C' LOA (Level of Achievement) in English by 5% in all year levels;
- Students achieving a 'B' LOA (Level of Achievement) in English by 5% in all year levels; and
- Students achieving an 'A' LOA (Level of Achievement) in English by 5% in all year levels.

## Our initiatives include:

- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching English/Reading;
- Provide professional development and coaching to ensure teachers are able to plan and deliver highly effective, differentiated learning experiences;
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support and those with potential to achieve high results;
- Continue a PLC (Professional Learning Community) of teachers to share and evaluate strategies and their impact (PLTs/Collaborative Cycles of Inquiry); and
- Maintain/sustain Learning Journey Groups to enhance NAPLAN Plan.
